How do Christians, and the church, fight the temptation to be only inward looking?



- 1. Re-read the account in 2 Kings 6:24-7:20 and note again the sermon points.
- 2. Note Jesus's last command and how it should be our first priority. (Matthew 28:18-20)
- 3. Note how the Apostle Paul was greatly concerned that more and more people come to know Jesus and grow in Jesus.
 - Cf. Corinthians 9:19-23 & 2 Corinthians 4:15



- 1. How could you be used by Christ in your different spheres of influence?
- 2. How could we as a church connect more with our community for Jesus?

What it Means to Be Sent into the World

Jesus sends us into the world as he was sent into the world (John 17:18; 20:21). We have to penetrate other people's worlds, as he penetrated ours: the world of their thinking (as we struggle to understand their misunderstandings of the gospel), the world of their feeling (as we try to empathize with their pain), and the world of their living (as we sense the humiliation of their social situation, whether poverty, homelessness, unemployment or discrimination).
