Why is the world in the state that it is?



- RECAP: How did Isaiah and Jesus describe human beings? What did Jesus come to do? Cf. v18-19
- 2. What two facts about Jesus particularly impressed people at the synagogue? Note the even more specific testimony of the demons. Why did Jesus silence them?

- How did Jesus exorcise demons and heal people? Why is this significant? (Remember Genesis 1) How did Jesus' exorcism and healing picture the Kingdom of God coming in all its fullness? (cf. Revelation 21:1-4)
- This passage illustrates the busyness and urgency of Jesus' mission (cf. esp. v18-19, v43). Why did Jesus depart to a desolate place? (Cf. 5:16; 6:12; 9:18, 28; 11:1 etc.) What can we learn?



- 1. Note the different responses to Jesus. Which one is closest to yours?
- 2. Note that the demon's theology was spot on and that the demon was quite happy to be in the synagogue. What warning should we heed?
- 3. What do we mean when we say that we live in the "NOW/NOT YET" in terms of the Kingdom of God?
