## **B. FROM THE BIBLE**

- 1. V1-3. Note that Jesus welcomed women as friends & onto his ministry team.
- 2. V4-15. What sorts of people do the four kinds of soil represent?
- 3. V16-21. What do these verses teach about: (a) the responsibilities and (b) the privileges of Jesus' followers?
- 4. Why did Jesus use parables in his teaching? (v9, 10) Do verses 4 & 18 provide a clue?

### C. IMPLICATIONS FOR ME

- 1. What experience have you of the truth of this parable in yourself and in others?
- 2. V18. We would do well to examine our lives: do we exercise care in how we respond to the Word of God? Can you point to places in your life where you have done something (or refrained from doing something) simply because you wanted to put Jesus' words into practice?
- 3. Are you able to discern threats to the growth of the "seed" (fruitfulness) in your life? Are there ways that you may have allowed the devil, or life's trials, or the deceitfulness of riches to choke the growth of God's Word?
