Faith Over Fear Luke 8: 40-56






What are some of the most fearful and hopeless situations people could find themselves in?

- What news does Jairus receive (v. 49), how does he respond, and how does Jesus challenge him to respond instead? (v. 50, 51).
- What is the outcome of faith in both accounts? (v. 48, 56).



- How do you think Jesus challenges us to be faithful amidst our fears and hopeless situations?
