Title: When Jesus comes to visit

Passage: Luke 19:1-10

THE FOR ALL

A. SERMON POINTS

- 1. A searching sinner
- 2. A seeking Saviour
- 3. A saved 'son of Abraham'
- 4. A transformed and staying saint

B. DISCUSSION STARTER

Have you ever had an uninvited guest? What happened? Was it a good or bad experience?

C. FROM THE BIBLE

- 1. What do we know about Zaccheus? Why is he a very unlikely candidate to be visited by Jesus?
- 2. Compare Zaccheus, the blind man (18:35-43) and the Rich, Young Ruler (18:18-29). What are the similarities and the differences?
- 3. Who took the initiative in the salvation of Zaccheus?
- 4. What can we learn from Zaccheus' expressions of repentance (v8)?
- 5. Jesus came to seek and save the lost. People like Zaccheus and you & I. How would Jesus accomplish our salvation? Cf. 18:31-33

D. IMPLICATIONS FOR ME

- 1. Is there a Zaccheus in your neighbourhood or social circle? What is your attitude towards them? Do you possibly consider yourself as not good enough for Jesus to save or have fellowship with?
- 2. What do Zaccheus' expressions of repentance show us about the Christian's attitude to: (1) making amends for wrongdoing and (2) money and wealth?
- 3. Many people (Christians and non-Christians) think they need to clean up their life first before they return to Jesus or church. What does the account of Zaccheus teach us?
